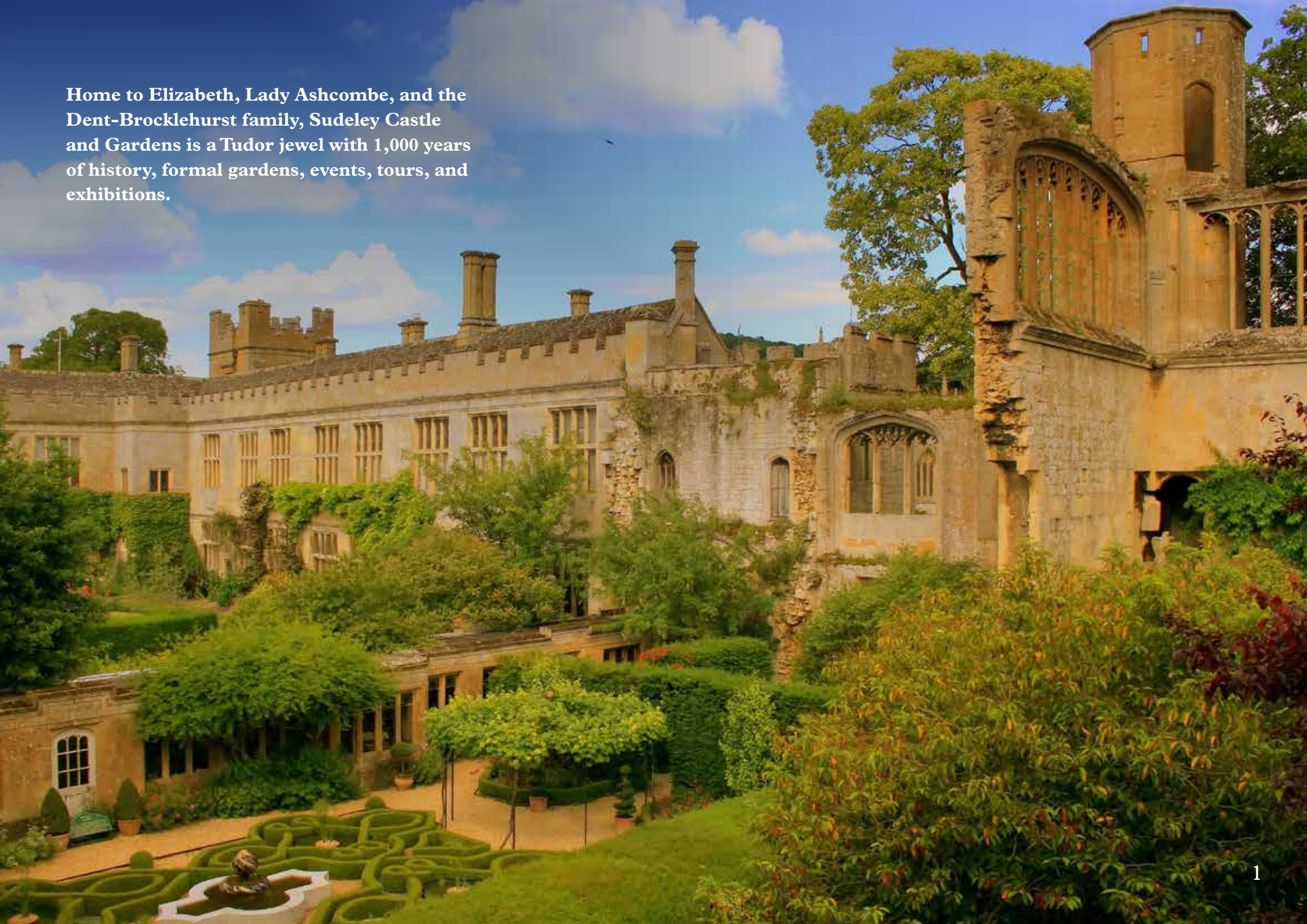

## St Mary's Chapel



Discover the resting place of Queen Katherine Parr, the sixth and final wife of Henry VIII.

## Castle Rooms



Sudeley's family rooms are home to many treasures, objects, and paintings including Turner, van Dyke, as well as 'The Allegory of the Tudor Succession' commissioned by Elizabeth I.

## The Ruins



Rambling roses tumble over the time-softened gothic ruins of the 15th century royal apartments which became a target for Oliver Cromwell's troops during the English Civil War.

## Animal Ark

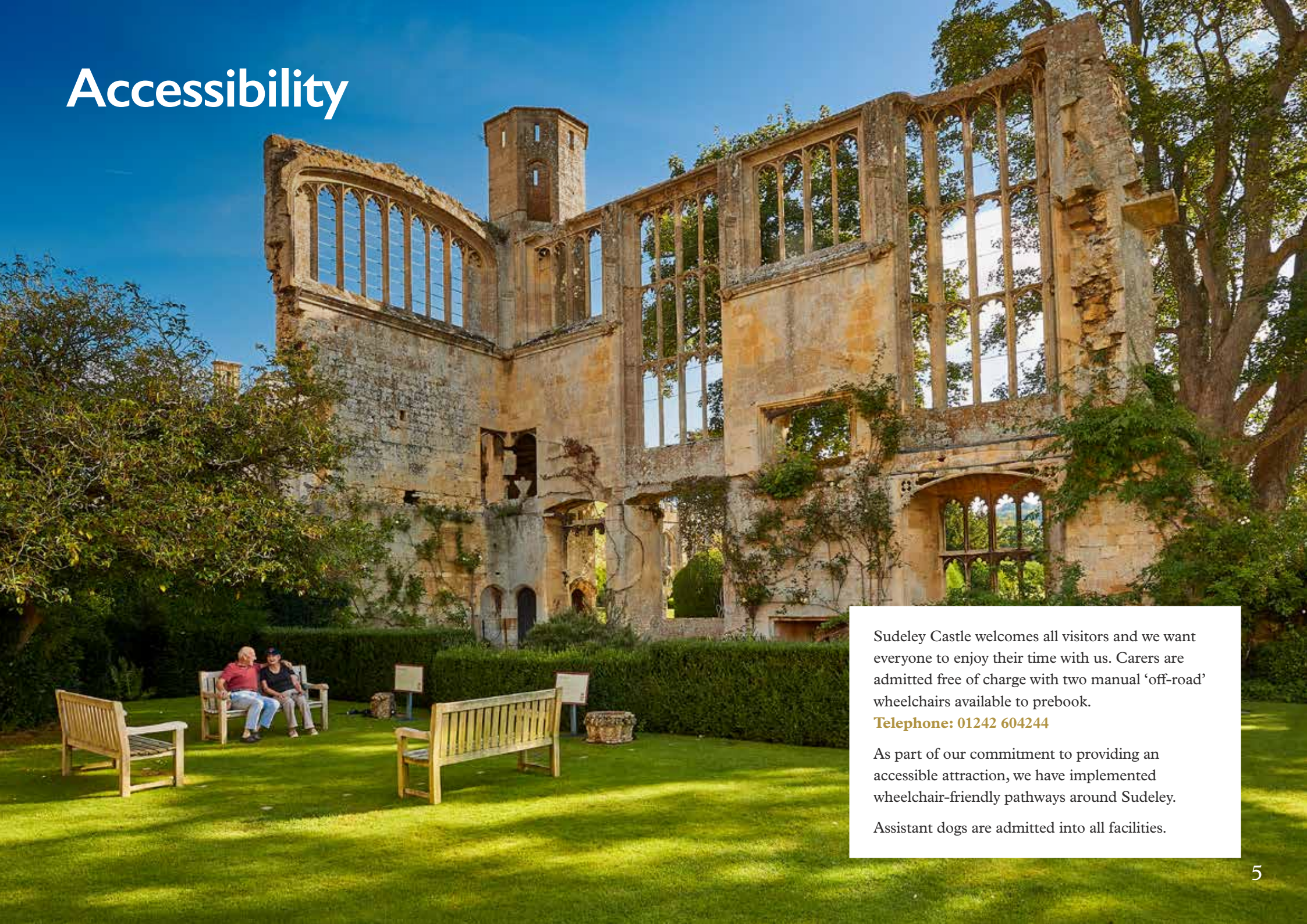
