Royal Ruins

The ancient remains of this 15th century barn frame the castle with its crumbling walls and beds of roses, bluebells and foxgloves. Giant carp swim in the mirror-like pond between the castle and the barn.

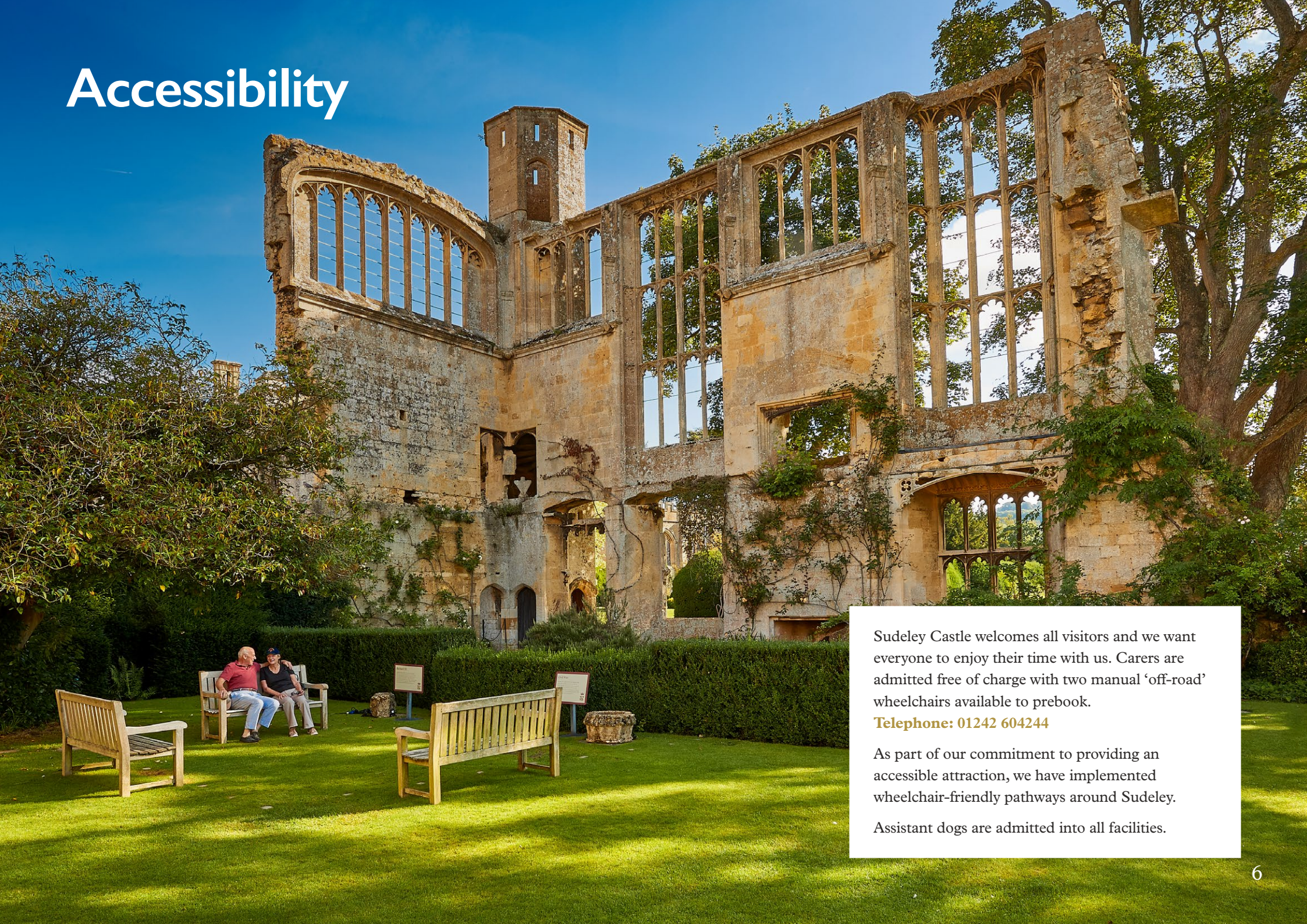
